



Europe is about to become more attractive for the exploration of raw materials. In the framework of the EU-funded INFACT project, partners drawn from research and industry are developing **innovative, non-invasive exploration technologies** and will test them under realistic conditions. The project aims at developing technologies that are **more acceptable to society** and which will invigorate and equip the exploration industry, unlocking unrealised potential in new and mature areas. For this purpose, **three European reference areas** are being established in Germany (Geyer), Finland (Sakatti) and Spain (Minas de Ríotinto, Gerena).
