Book review

Small Tertiary Foraminifers from Bulgaria — Atlas by Stefka Darakchieva

The 486 species of benthic and planktonic foraminifers from the Tertiary in Bulgaria are illustrated in 80 plates. Their arrangement is according to the classification by Loeblich & Tappan of 1988 year. All illustrations are accompanied by bibliographical data, chronostratigraphic range of the species in Bulgaria, its lithostratigraphic and geographic occurrence.

The unified presentation of the data and excellent

photographs makes the Atlas easy to use for everyone who is interested in Tertiary foraminifers. In this sense it deserves the attention as of the forams' researchers, as well as for people with wider professional interest and amateurs.

The important value of the Atlas are also more than 180 bibliographical titles, including all related to the Bulgarian Tertiary foraminifers.
